



## Jeanne L. Hammond Memorial Scholarship

### Information for Scholarship Applicants

The **BPW/Maine Futurama Foundation** awards a scholarship in the amount of **\$1500** in memory of Jeanne L. Hammond. Mrs. Hammond was a member of BPW for over 50 years. She worked tirelessly with Waterville BPW, BPW/Maine, the Futurama Foundation scholarship program and the Maine Women's Hall of Fame. Mrs. Hammond was honored as both BPW/Waterville and BPW/Maine Member of the Year, as AAUW Achievement Citation Award recipient in 2000 and as BPW/Waterville Volunteer of the Year at the REM Community Awards Ceremony in 2005.

The Jeanne L. Hammond Memorial Scholarship is given annually to a woman, who is a Maine resident, with demonstrated financial need, to obtain an undergraduate degree or certification on at least a half-time basis. Primary consideration will be given to those with dedicated school and/or community involvement in order to honor Jeanne's life and accomplishments. Secondary preference will be given to those women seeking a journalism degree; members or former members or their female dependents of BPW/Maine; members or their female dependents of American Association of University Women.

The scholarship is designed to assist a female student in meeting educational expenses for the second semester of the first year of post-secondary study **OR** who will have completed at least one year of college requiring attendance for at least one more year. *The scholarship payment will be made directly to the school to be applied to the **second academic term**. The Maine Community Foundation will send a check in December to school/college; if student is still enrolled, both school/college and student must sign check.*

### Criteria

The applicant must meet the following requirements:

- Be a Maine resident who will graduate or has graduated from high school and who will enroll in an accredited college or school post-secondary education this year.
- Demonstrate financial need.
- Have a realistic goal relating to educational plans.

### Requirements

The following items must be submitted with the application:

- Completed application form, **with statement of financial need completed by a Financial Aid Official or Guidance Counselor**.
- Official transcript from high school(s) or college(s).
- Verification of acceptance from the college or school.
- At least two letters of recommendations pertinent to this application. These may be from school officials, teachers, employers, or other persons not related to applicant.



- A **hand signed** statement by the applicant describing educational and personal goals. This should include applicant's financial need and family financial situation. Information about school activities, employment, and any unusual circumstances may be pertinent to include. Electronic signature not accepted. Also, include if you or a relative are a member of BPW or AAUW, if so the name of the relative and relationship.
- If necessary, use an additional sheet to show leadership qualities, community involvement, non-traditional or stellar activities. If high school senior, show how heavily involved in high school/community activities.

\*No application will be considered complete until all supporting materials are received.

The deadline for completed applications is **April 13<sup>th</sup>**. *Late applications will not be considered.* Please send all materials to:
